## **VISION & PURPOSE**

The Grandview SDA Church was started in the early 1900's by a group of people very much dedicated to the Lord and the furthering of the gospel. From the very start they realized that Christian education was important and so started a school. The church and school grew until in the 1950's and 1960's the church had more than 500 members attending and a school of 70-100 students.

The early pioneers of this church were very liberal in their support of the church and especially education. This endowment to help students attain a Christian education is being setup to keep alive the memory and vision of these early pioneers who gave sacrificially at times so not only their children, but children of those that could not afford Christian education could attend our schools.

- Students interested in receiving a Grandview Pioneer Memorial Scholarship must submit a completed Application by July 31, 2019.
- The FoundationONE Scholarship Committee will review the applications and choose the winner(s).
- Awards will be presented at an Assembly in November, 2019.
- Awards may be renewed from year to year, but students need to apply each year.
