

#### ERIC MOLSTEAD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

#### **VISION & PURPOSE**

Eric Molstead, a member of the Upper Columbia Academy Class of 1980, died in an airplane accident while returning from his 25<sup>th</sup> class reunion in 2005. An Eric Molstead memorial Scholarship Fund has been established in his honor to encourage and support young women interested in careers in math and science. Four scholarships are awarded each year, one to a freshman, one to a sophomore, one to a junior, and one to a senior. Once a recipient is chosen, her scholarship will be renewed year after year, assuming she continues to qualify.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Eric Molstead Scholarships are limited to women who attend Upper Columbia Academy.
- Successful candidates will demonstrate interest and academic achievement in science and/or math
- Students must have a 3.5 GPA in math and science.
- Successful candidates will be pursuing a career in science and/or math.

#### **APPLICATION & RENEWAL PROCESS**

Students interested in receiving an Eric Molstead Scholarship must:

- Write a one-page essay of justification to the FoundationONE Scholarship Committee.
- Secure two letters of recommendation from UCA faculty members, one of which will be a math/ science teacher.
- Submit the completed Application, essay, and letters of recommendation to FoundationONE by October 25, 2019. (PO Box 744, Post Falls, ID 83877, or linda.klinger@foundationoneuca.org).
- The FoundationONE Scholarship Committee will review applications, essays, and recommendations, and will make the final selections.
- The Eric Molstead Scholarship awards will be presented at a school Assembly in November.
- Students who are successful in achieving an Eric Molstead Scholarship must maintain a 3.5 GPA in science and math. If an Eric Molstead Scholar's GPA drops below 3.5, one semester of probation may be granted. The decision will be made by the FoundationONE Scholarship Committee.
